- 1. FOOTINGS Prior to placement of concrete for verification of depth Certified plot plan
- 2. FOUNDATION ready to backfill, water proofed, foundation drains installed
- 3. BUILDING framed and rough electrical, plumbing (to be concealed fire stops).
- 4. INSULATION
- 5. DRIVEWAY A driveway permit (if necessary) must be on file and approved by Road Agent.
- 6. OIL BURNER Contact the Fire Department for inspection
- 7. FINAL Certificate of Occupancy to be issued
- 8. STREET NUMBERS must be installed in a permanent location visible from street. The minimum size is 3" high by 2" wide and the colors should be contrasting.

All inspections must be completed within seventy-two (72) hours AFTER Building Inspector is notified.
